

ADVENT ornaments

Supplies:

- Cardstock & Scissors or paper trimmer
- Printer
- Laminator (optional)
- String, garland, or small Christmas Tree
- Mini wooden clothes pins (Found in most craft stores)

Option 1: If you want to print my advent ideas print pages 3-4 then flip and print pgs 5-6 on the back. Optional: Laminate for durability! *(Make sure to put them in the same direction so the writing prints in the correct spot.)*

Option 2: If you would like to use your own ideas, just print pages 3-4 then write in your own ideas on the back of each ornament before laminating.

Directions:

Print the ornaments as directed above on cardstock. Cut out each triangle and use mini-clothes pins to attach ornaments to a small Christmas Tree, a string of garland, or a rope hung across the mantle.

Starting on December 1st, each day pick one ornament off the tree and do whatever it says on the back of the card.

Most are easy to complete with simple household items, however some are crafts so you may want to plan ahead for those days, see below for a list of items you will need.
