Sin/Offense	Consequence:	Scripture:
Hitting/Being Mean	<p><i>Potty Talk:</i> As a rule we don't speak of anything we wouldn't want to eat.</p> <p><i>Unkind words:</i> Apologize to offended party and say 3 nice things about them. Pray together.</p>	<p>Eph 4:32 "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you"</p> <p>Prov 11:17 "A kind man benefits himself, but a cruel man brings trouble on himself"</p>
Lying	<p>"Spank" tongue with hotsauce. Pray together.</p>	<p>Ps 34:13 "Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking lies"</p> <p>Prov 12:22 "The LORD detests lying lips, but he delights in men who are truthful"</p>
Disobedience	<p>Separation from family (like separation from God) - 10 minutes room time, finish by praying together.</p>	<p>Col 3:20 "Children obey your parents in the Lord for this is right"</p>
Arguing or Complaining	<p><i>With Mom:</i> Laundry Break until they are ready to shine like stars (see scripture) Also reference disobedience verse.</p> <p><i>Over a Toy:</i> We want to remove anything that causes us to sin so the toy goes.</p> <p>Pray together.</p>	<p>Phil 2:14-15 14 "Do everything without complaining or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe"</p> <p>1 Thess 5:18 "give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus"</p>
Attitude	<p>Break in laundry room until they can come out with a genuinely good attitude.</p> <p>Pray together.</p>	<p>Prov 17:22 "A cheerful heart is good medicine but a crushed spirit dries up the bones"</p>
Unkind Words/ Language	<p><i>Potty Talk:</i> As a rule we don't speak of anything we wouldn't want to eat.</p> <p><i>Unkind words:</i> Apologize to offended party and say 5 nice things about them.</p> <p>Pray together.</p>	<p>Prov 15:1 "A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger"</p> <p>Eph 4:29 "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen"</p>
Sibling Conflict	<p>I step close enough to let them know I'm watching them, give them a couple minutes to work it out, if they don't I let them know I'll be happy to work it out for them but neither of them will like my solution.</p> <p>Would either of them like to be like Jesus and be the peacemaker? Pray together.</p>	<p>Matt 5:9 "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God"</p> <p>Romans 12:21 "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."</p> <p>Eph 4:2-3 "Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. 3Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace"</p>
