5. Finds peace in Jesus, regardless of her circumstances. (Isa 26:3, John 14:27, John 15:5)
6. Remembers that God's power is made perfect in her weakness. (2 Cor 12:9-10)
7. Extends grace to herself and others. (Eph 4:32)
8. Builds relationships with her children, teaches them to be godly. (Deut 6:6-7)
9. Chooses "the most excellent way" – living a life of love; giving, sharing, serving God and others. (Eph 5:1-3, 1 Cor 13)
10. Focuses on what is unseen and eternal. (2 Cor 4:17-18, Col 3:2)
