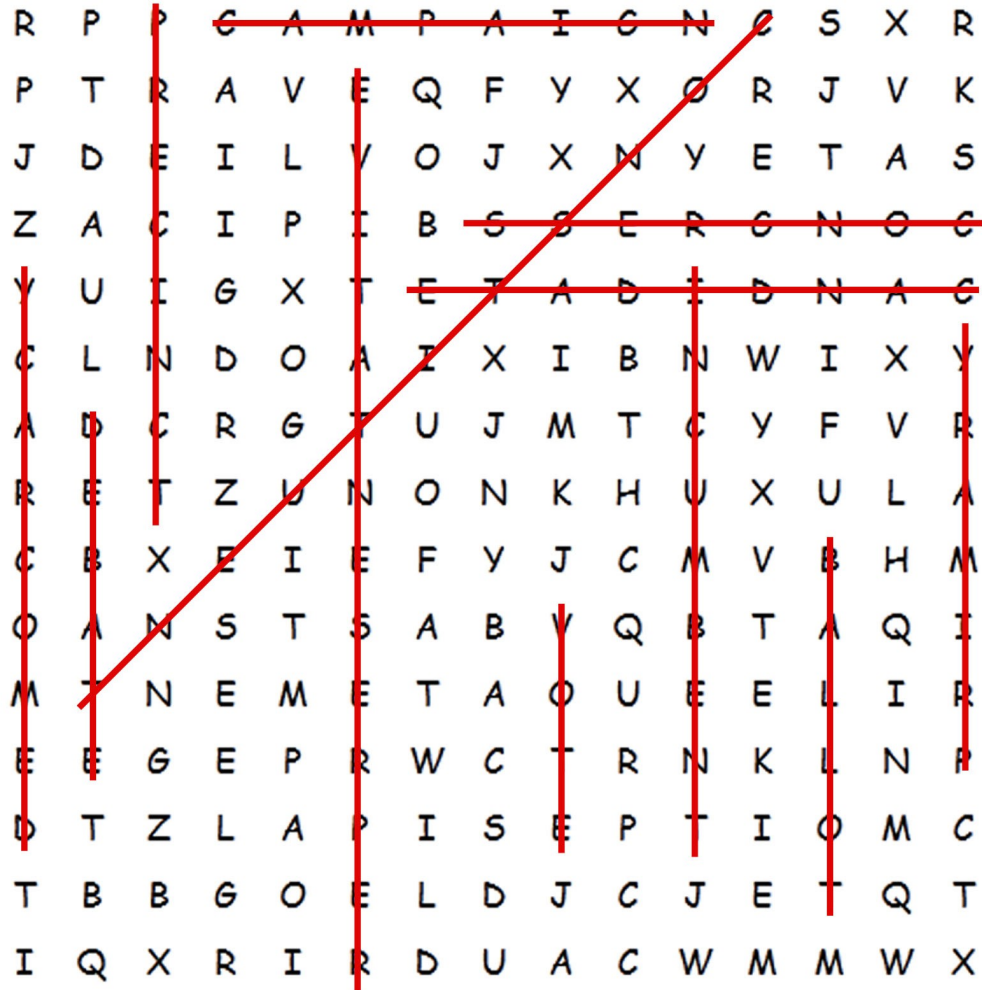
I Voted Stickers!
