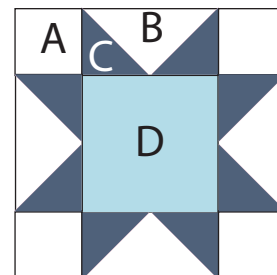

Sawtooth Block #1

		12.5" Block	6.5" Block
Background 1 F8	A	(4) 3-1/2" square	(4) 2" square
	B	(1) 7-1/4" square	(1) 4-1/4" square
Prints 1 F8	C	(1) 7-3/4" square	(1) 4-3/4" square
	D	(1) 6-1/2" square	(1) 3-1/2" square



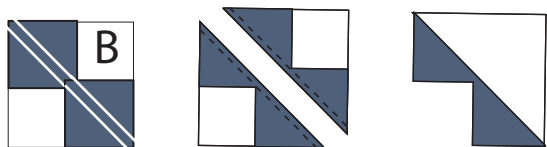
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the C square. Next draw lines 1/4" away from the center lines as shown below.



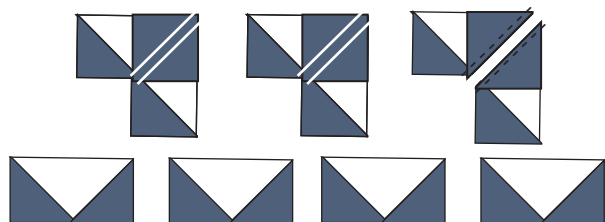
Fold the C square in half both ways to mark the center, then cut the C square into quarters along the folded lines.



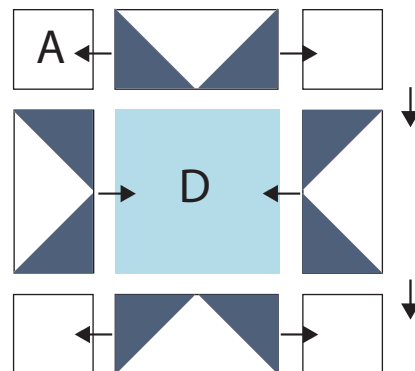
Layer two C squares on opposite corners of a B square. Sew on the drawn lines and cut apart down the center of the sewn lines and press. Make two.



Layer a C square on the top corner of one B unit as shown. Sew on both of the drawn lines and cut between the sewn lines. Trim to 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" or 2" x 3-1/2". Make four.



Assemble Block #1 as shown, press seams in opposite directions as indicated by arrows so they nest. Trim completed block to 12-1/2" square or 6-1/2" square.
