Sew With Me Douple Pinwheel Block \#9

Sew an A rectangle to a $C$ rectangle and press towards the $C$ fabric. Make 2 strip sets.

Cut each strip set into two $7-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ or 4" $\times 4$ " square sections.


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $B$ squares. and cut them in half along the drawn line.

TIP: Spray with Mary Ellen's Best Press prior to cutting to help give the bias edge more stability.


Place a B triangle right side down on to an $A / C s$ quare as shown below then sew 1/4 from the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from stitch line and press. Make four identical units.

Trim to $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.


Assemble the block as shown below.
Trim to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


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
