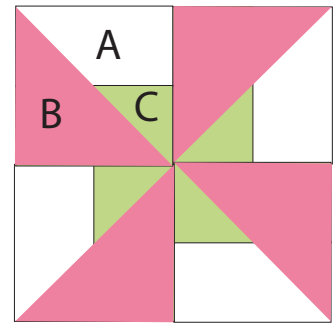




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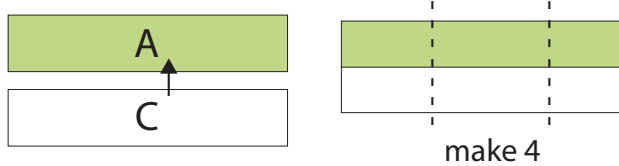
Sew With Me Double Pinwheel Block #9

		12.5" Block	6.5" Block
Background	A	(2) 4" x 15"	(2) 2-1/4" x 9"
1 FQ			
Prints	B	(2) 7-1/4" square	(2) 4" square
2 different F8s	C	(2) 4" x 15"	(2) 2-1/4" x 9"



Sew an A rectangle to a C rectangle and press towards the C fabric. Make 2 strip sets.

Cut each strip set into two 7-1/4" x 7-1/4" or 4" x 4" square sections.



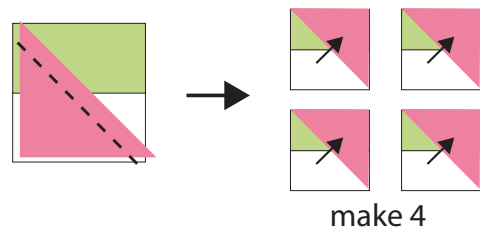
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the B squares, and cut them in half along the drawn line.

TIP: Spray with Mary Ellen's Best Press prior to cutting to help give the bias edge more stability.



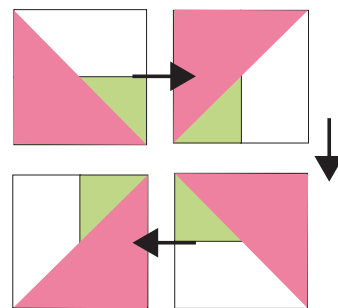
Place a B triangle right side down on to an A/C square as shown below then sew 1/4" from the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from stitch line and press. Make four identical units.

Trim to 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" or 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" square.



Assemble the block as shown below.

Trim to 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" or 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
