



# 2021-2022 Sew With Me

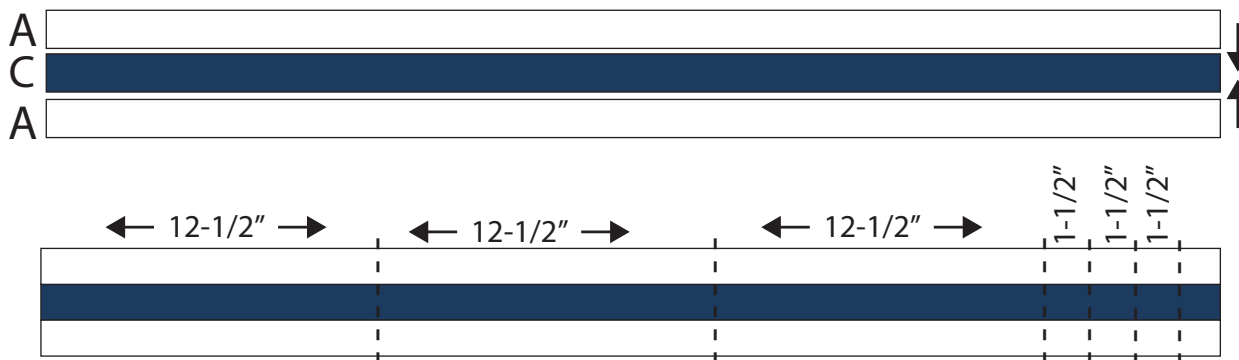
## Finishing

Finishing Sashing & Borders		WOF = width of fabric (42")	
Sashing (white)	1-1/2 yards (white)	A	(24) 1-1/2" x WOF"
Border 1 (white)		B	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF"
Sashing (Navy)	3/4 yard (navy)	C	(15) 1-1/2" x WOF"
Border 2 (Aqua)	1-1/3 yards (aqua)	D	(7) 6-1/2" x WOF"

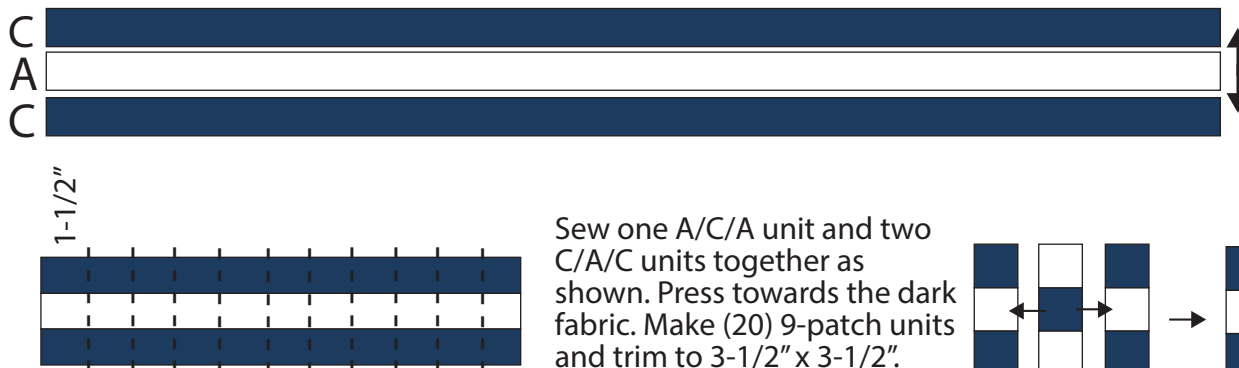

### SASHING:

Sew a fabric A, C, and A strip together along the long edge using 1/4" seam. Press towards the dark fabric. Make 11 strip sets. Subcut each strip set into (3) 12-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips and (3) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2". Make a total of (31) 12-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips and (20) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips.



Sew two C strips and one A strip together as shown. Press towards the dark fabric. Make 2 strip sets. Subcut into (40) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips.



### BORDERS:

Sew Border 1 (B) strips end to end, then subcut into (2) 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" (B1) and (2) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" (B2). Sew Border 2 (D) strips end to end, then subcut into (2) 6-1/2" x 67-1/2" (D1) and (2) 6-1/2" x 64-1/2" (D2).



Assemble the quilt center by sewing the rows together as shown below, press towards the 12-1/2" sashing strips on each row.

Next sew BORDER 1 strips (B1) to the right and left sides. Then sew top/bottom strips (B2) on. Finally sew BORDER 2 strips (D1) to the right and left sides. Then sew top/bottom strips (D2) on.

Baste, quilt, and bind using desired method. See my YouTube channel for tutorials if you need help!
