Finished Size:
66" x 81"

Fabric Requirements:

Background: 2-3/4 yards

Blocks: 14 Red FQs

Sashing & Border 2:

1 yard pink

1/4 yard red

Border 3: 2 yards Low Vol.

Binding: 5/8 yard Red

Backing/Batting: 5 yards

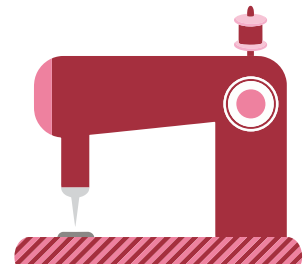
For the 12½" blocks, I'm using a mix of red fabrics from my stash and the Fat Quarter Shop Red Sampler FQ Bundle. For the 6½" blocks I am using Christmas Stitched by FigTree for Moda Fabrics.

Details:

- QAL includes patterns for 12 quilt blocks + finishing options and bonus ideas!
- Blocks will be available in 6½" and 12½"
- Videos release the 2nd Thursday of the month
- Free PDF downloads included for each block (*Full pattern will be available in my shop once all blocks are released*)
- I suggest prepping your fabric with starch or Mary Ellen's Best Press prior to cutting your pieces.

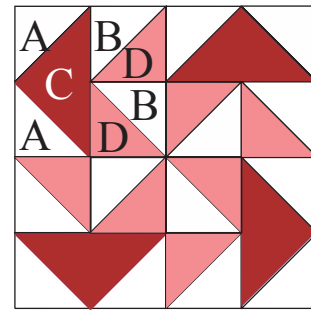
Supplies:

- Oliso Pro Smart Iron
- Creative Grids Rulers (5-1/2" square, 12-1/2" square)
- Riley Blake Tailor's Clapper
- Modern American Vintage Tailor's Clapper
- Olfa 45mm Rotary Trimmer
- Fat Quarter Shop Rotating Cutting Mat
- Mary Ellen's Best Press

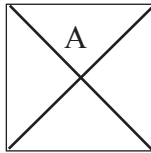




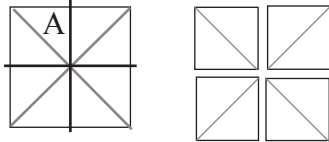

Background 1 F8	A	(1) 7-3/4" x 7-3/4"	(1) 4-3/4" x 4-3/4"
	B	(2) 6-1/4" x 6-1/4"	(2) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
Prints 2 Red F8s	C	(1) 7-1/4" x 7-1/4"	(1) 4-1/4" x 4-1/4"
	D	(2) 6-1/4" x 6-1/4"	(2) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"



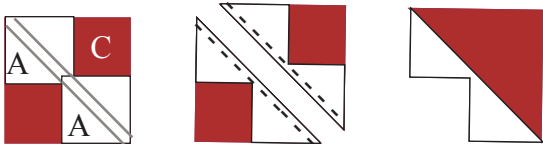
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the A square.



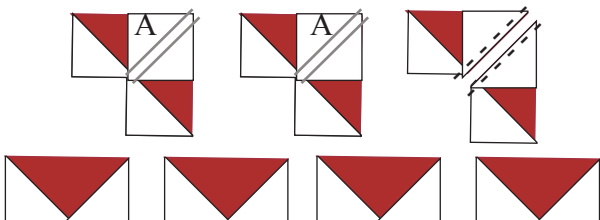
Fold the A square in half both ways to mark the center, then cut the A square into quarters along the folded lines.



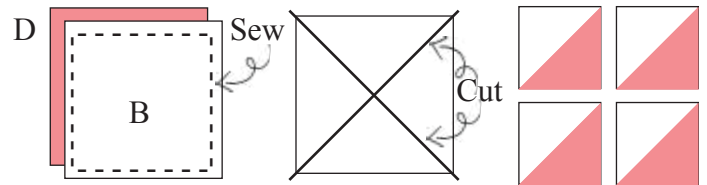
Layer two A squares on opposite corners of a C square. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut down the center of the sewn lines and press. Make 2.



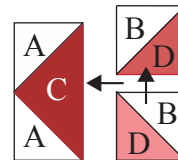
Layer an A square on the top corner of one C unit as shown. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut down the center of the sewn lines and press. Trim to 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" or 2" x 3-1/2". Make four.



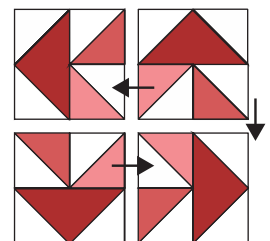
Place a B and D square right sides together. Sew around all four sides using 1/4" seam. Cut the square in half on both diagonals and press. Make 4 half square triangles. Repeat with remaining B and D squares. Trim to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" or 2" x 2".



Sew two B/D HSTs together as shown. Sew an A/C rectangle to the left side as shown. Make 4 corner units.



Assemble block as shown. Trim to 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" or 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
