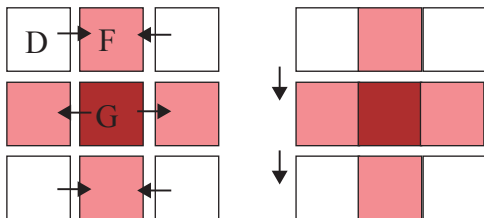
Sew two A and two H squares together as shown. Make 4.



Sew a B and E rectangle together. Make 4.

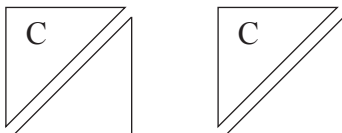


Sew four D squares, four F squares, and a G square together as shown.

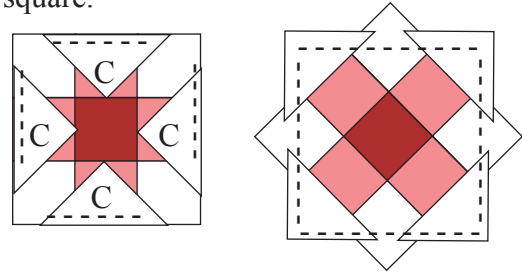


Cut the C squares in half diagonally.

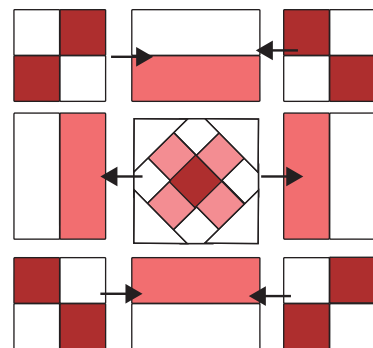
TIP: To help keep the C triangles from distorting, spray with Mary Ellen's Best Press prior to cutting.



Sew a C triangle to each side of the F squares as shown. Turn block 45° and trim to 6-1/2" square or 3-1/2" square.



Assemble the block as shown below. Trim to 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" or 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
