Sew a B, E, and B unit together as shown. Make 2.


Sew a B, D, F, D, and B unit together as shown. Make 2.


Sew an A, E, F, C, F, E, and A unit together as shown. Make 1.


Using remaining A triangles, assemble block as shown below.


Turn block 45 degrees and trim to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $12-1 / 2$ " or $6-1 / 2$ " x $6-1 / 2$ ".
