| Sashing (Red) <br> Border 2 (Red) | 1/4 yard | $\begin{aligned} & \mathrm{H} \\ & \mathrm{~J} 1, \mathrm{~J} 2 \end{aligned}$ | (3) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF + (1) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ <br> (7) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF - Sew end to end, subcut into <br> (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (J1) and (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (J2) |
| Border 3 (Low Vol) | 1-7/8 yard | K1, K2 | (7) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sew end to end, subcut into <br> (2) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 69-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (K1) and (2) 6-1/2" $\times 66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (K2) |
| Binding | 5/8 yard | L | (8) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF - Sew end to end, bind using preferred method. |

Cut the D squares in half diagonally. TIP: To help keep the triangles from distorting, spray with Mary Ellen's Best Press prior to cutting.


Sew an A, F, A, and F strip together. Repeat with remaining A and F strips to make 2 sets. Trim strip sets into a total of (31) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units.


## Cornerstones:

Sew a C, H. and C strip together along the long edge using $1 / 4$ " seam. Press towards the dark fabric. Make one WOF strip set + one $20^{\prime \prime}$ strip set . Subcut the strip sets into a total of (40) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" C/H/C units.
Repeat with the H, G, and H strips to make one WOF strip set. Subcut the strip set into a total of (20) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{G}$ units


Sew two $\mathrm{C} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{C}$ units and one $\mathrm{H} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{H}$ unit together. Trim to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 20. Place a D triangle on all four sides of the 9 -patch and sew using $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam as shown. Turn block $45^{\circ}$ and trim to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 20.

Sew four Corner Stones and three sashing units together. Make (5) 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" horizontal sashing strips.


Sew four sashing strips and three 12 " blocks together. Make (4) 12-1/2" x 48-1/2" horizontal block rows. Press towards the sashing strips.


## Quilt Assembly:

Assemble the quilt center alternating the horizontal sashing rows and block rows as shown below. Press towards the sashing strips on each row.

Sew BORDER 1 strips (E1) to the right and left sides. Then sew top/bottom strips (E2) on. Next sew BORDER 2 strips (J1) to the right and left sides. Then sew top/bottom strips (J2) on. Finally sew BORDER 3 strips (K1) to the right and left sides. Then sew top/bottom strips (K2) on.


Finishing: Baste, quilt, and bind using desired method. See my YouTube channel for tutorials if you need help!

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
