1-at-a-Time Flying Geese (with wiggle room)

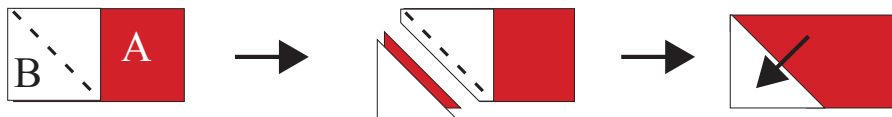
WIGGLE METHOD:

Rectangle (Goose) = 3/4" + Finished Width of Flying Geese Unit (cut 1)
 Corner Square (Sky) = 3/4" + Finished Height of Flying Geese Unit (cut 2)

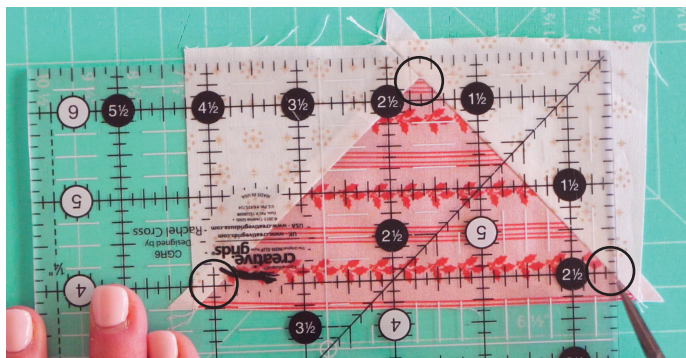
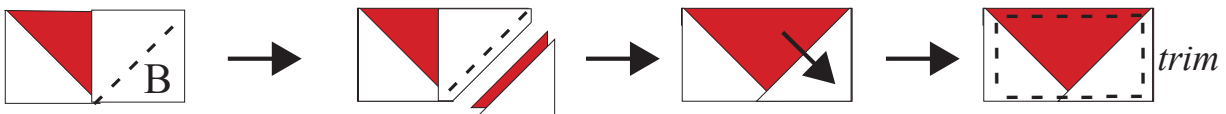
NO WIGGLE METHOD:

Rectangle (Goose) = 1/2" + Finished Width of Flying Geese Unit (cut 1)
 Corner Squares (Sky) = 1/2" + Finished Height of Flying Geese Unit (cut 2)

Sew a B square to an A rectangle along the diagonal line. Trim to 1/4" from stitch line and press.



Sew a B square to the other end of the A rectangle along the diagonal line. Trim to 1/4" from stitch line and press. Trim to the unfinished size as indicated in the chart.



TIP: To trim your "wobble room" Flying Geese unit, line up the point of the flying geese so it is 1/4" from the cut line. Then, line up the bottom marks so they hit the seam line between the goose and sky (see circle marks). Trim off excess fabric. Rotate unit, line up again and trim off remaining fabric for a perfect Flying Geese every time!

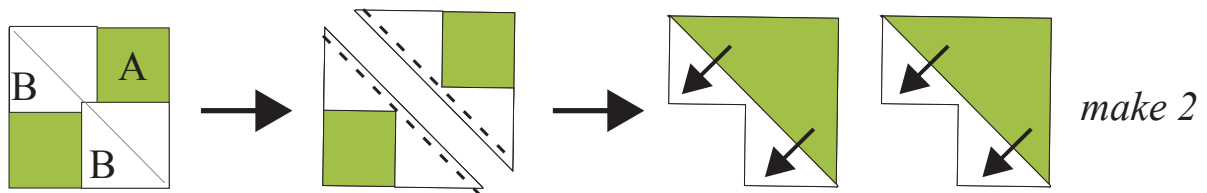
WIGGLE METHOD:

Center Square (Goose) = 1-3/4" + Finished Width of Flying Geese Unit (cut 1)
 Corner Squares (Sky) = 1-1/4" + Finished Height of Flying Geese Unit (cut 4)

NO WIGGLE METHOD:

Center Square (Goose) = 1-1/4" + Finished Width of Flying Geese Unit (cut 1)
 Corner Squares (Sky) = 7/8" + Finished Height of Flying Geese Unit (cut 4)

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the B squares. Layer two B squares on opposite corners of an A square. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut down the center of the sewn lines and press. Make 2.



Layer a B square on the top corner of one A unit as shown. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut down the center of the sewn lines and press. Make four. Trim to the unfinished size as indicated in the chart.
