

Quilty Star Tree Topper



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Supplies		qty	w x h
Variety of Fabric scraps	A	12-14	1½" x 8½"
Quilt Batting	B	2	10" x 10"
Needle & Thread	Scrap quantity and size will vary! Just have fun!		
Wooden Skewer			
Pillow Stuffing			



Finished Size:

7½" x 7½"

Place the batting fabric (B) right side up. Place two (A) strips right sides together along the left edge of the quilt batting (B). Sew the two strips together along the right side using a ¼" seam making sure to sew through all of the layers. Fold the fabric open, and continue adding new strips in the same way until the entire piece of batting is covered. Feel free to quilt the top of the strips as you go as well!

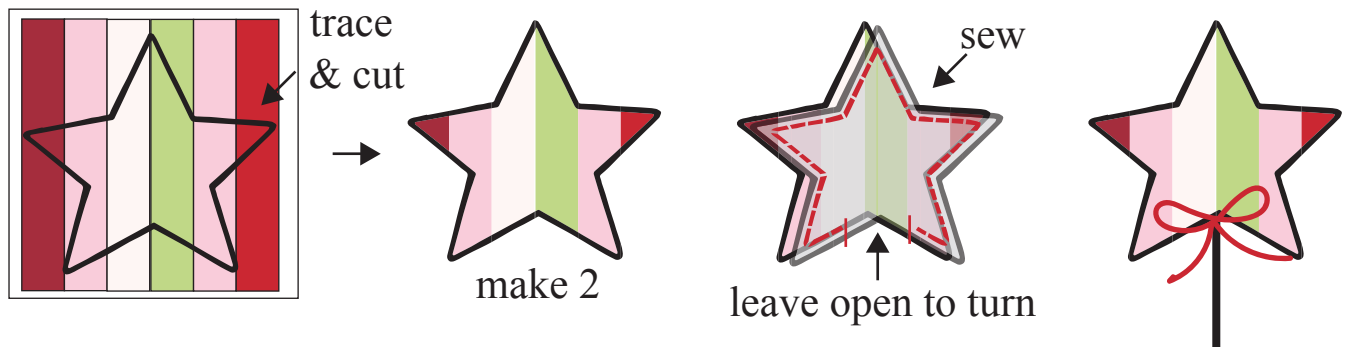
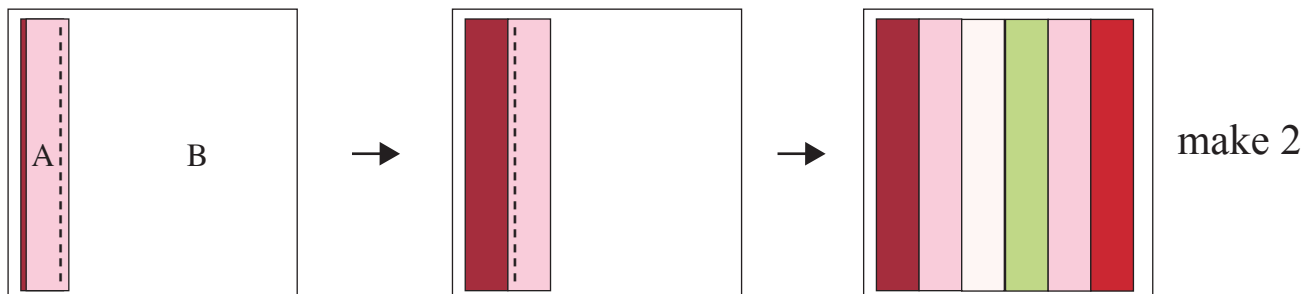
Trace the star template (see next page) onto the completed QAYG fabric and trace it using a Frixion erasable pen. Sew along the drawn line using a straight stitch. Make 2 QAYG stars.

Place the two QAYG stars right sides together and sew around the outside edge leaving a 1-1/2" opening at the bottom. Trim off the star tips to reduce bulk, do not cut into your stitch line.

Turn the star right side out and fill with pillow stuffing. Sew the opening closed, leaving a small hole at the base of the star for the wooden skewer to fit in.

Place the wooden skewer into your star through the hole in the bottom. Add to your tree top and enjoy!

Optional: Tie a decorative ribbon around the skewer.
